Installation of Landfill Gas Well and Gas Monitoring Probes.

The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is overseeing the onsite installation of landfill gas wells and the offsite installation of gas monitoring probes. The landfill gas wells will be installed onsite at BKK Class I Landfill at East Nanette Avenue, West Covina, and the probes will be installed offsite of the BKK Class I Landfill.

What is the purpose of the onsite landfill gas well installation?

The installation of the landfill gas wells will be done onsite at the BKK Class I Landfill to extract and treat landfill gas at the landfill for the protection of the community and the environment.

What is the purpose of the offsite probe installation?

The installation of the gas monitoring probes will be done offsite from the BKK Class I Landfill at East Nanette Avenue to detect the movement of gas away from the landfill for the protection of the community and the environment.

When work is scheduled

- Onsite work is scheduled to begin December 8, 2025; Offsite work is scheduled to begin January 5, 2026
- Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- The onsite work is expected to be completed December 23, 2025; Offsite work is expected to be completed February 27, 2026.

Safety measures

Work will occur under a Site-Specific Health and Safety Plan prepared in accordance with California Occupational Safety and Health Administration (Cal/OSHA).
